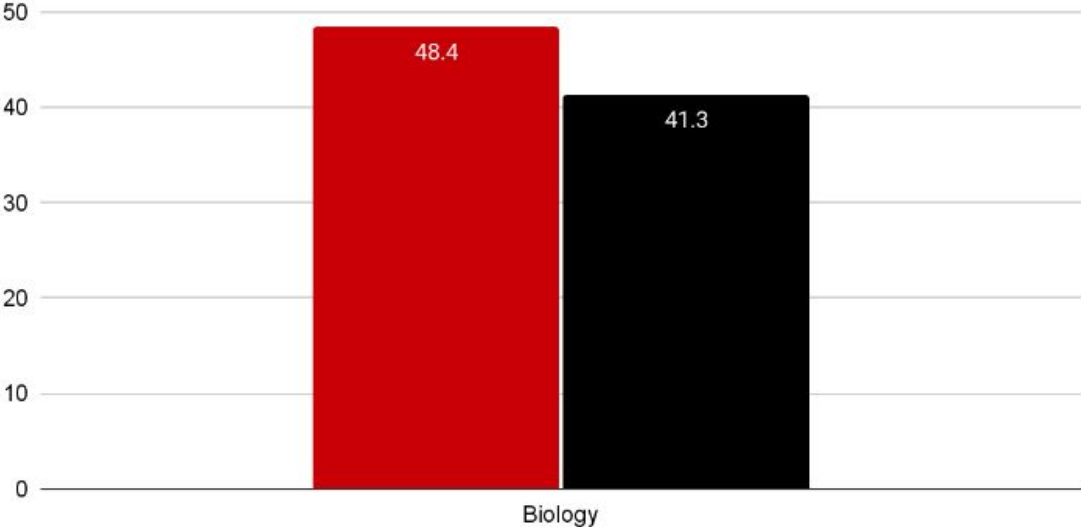

Projected Percent Proficiency: Biology

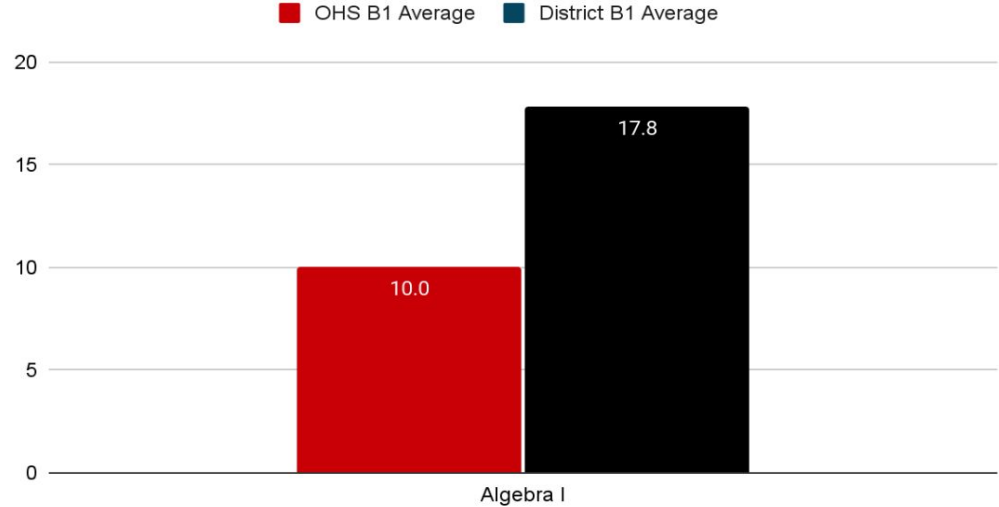

Projected Percent Proficiency: Algebra I

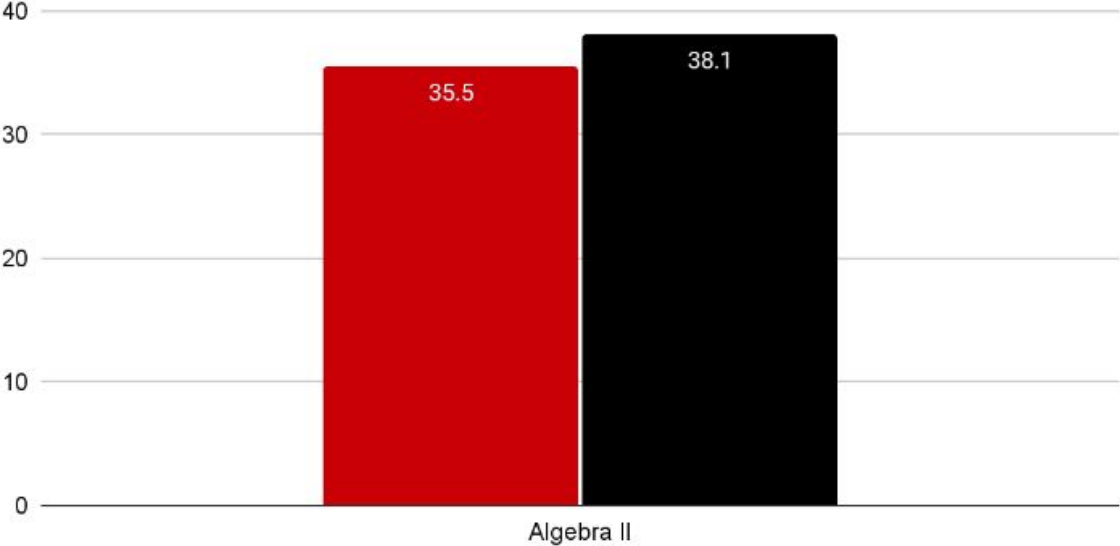


# Data Review: Benchmark 1 Algebra II

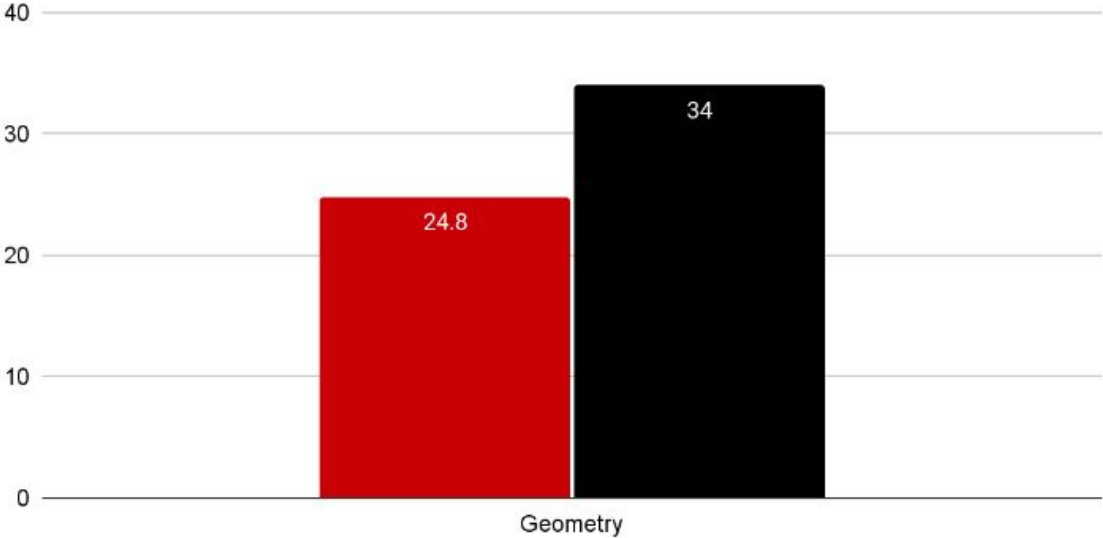


# Data Review: Benchmark 1 Geometry

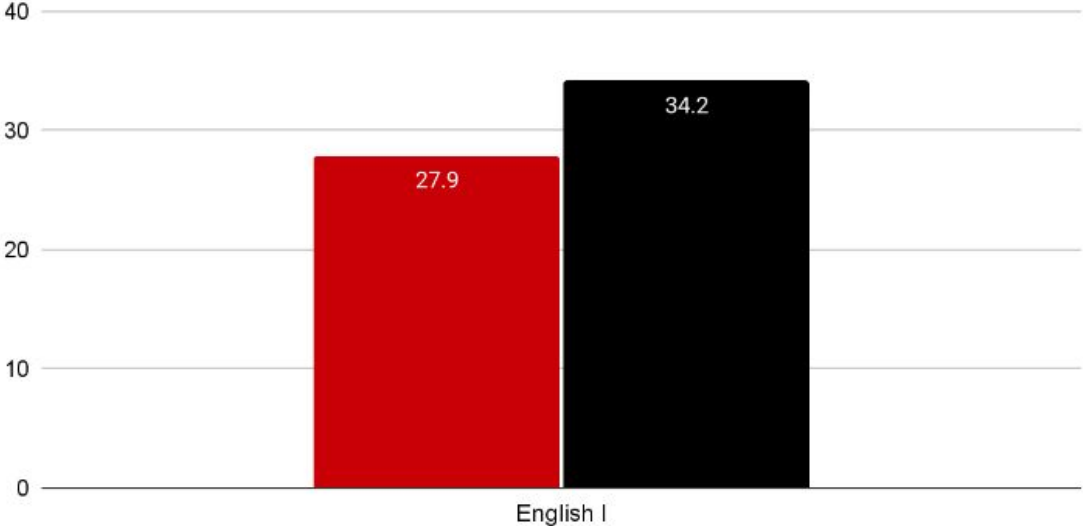

Projected Percent Proficiency: English I



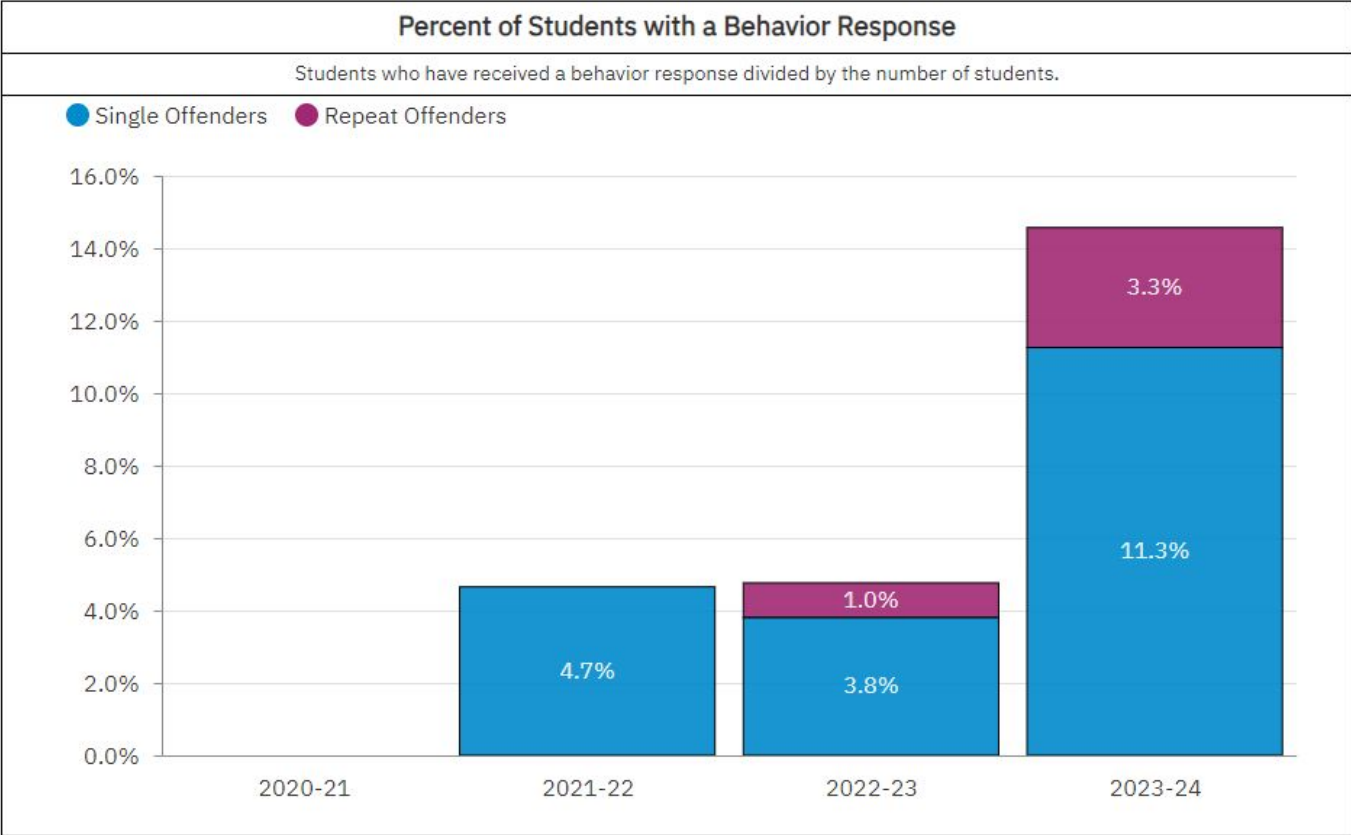

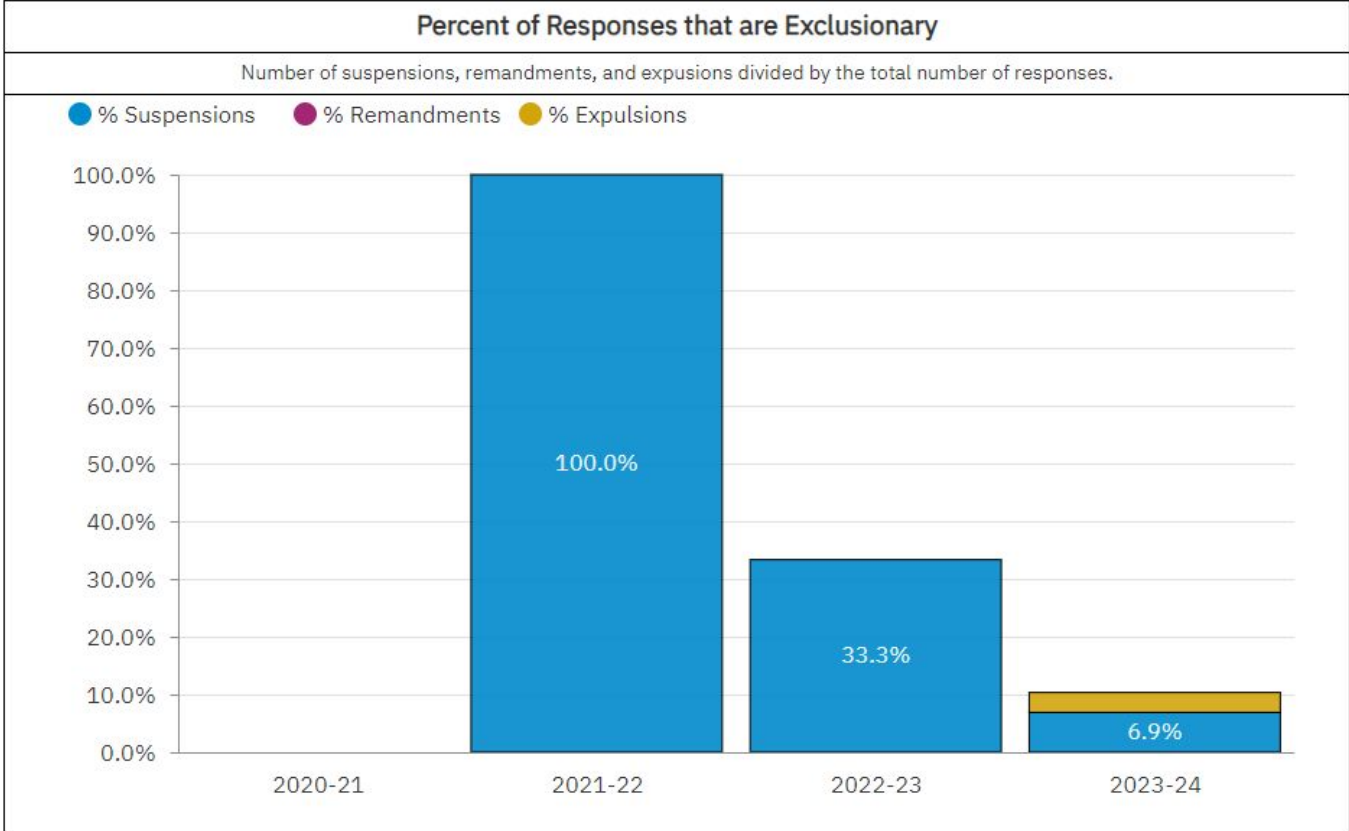

- Follow class routines

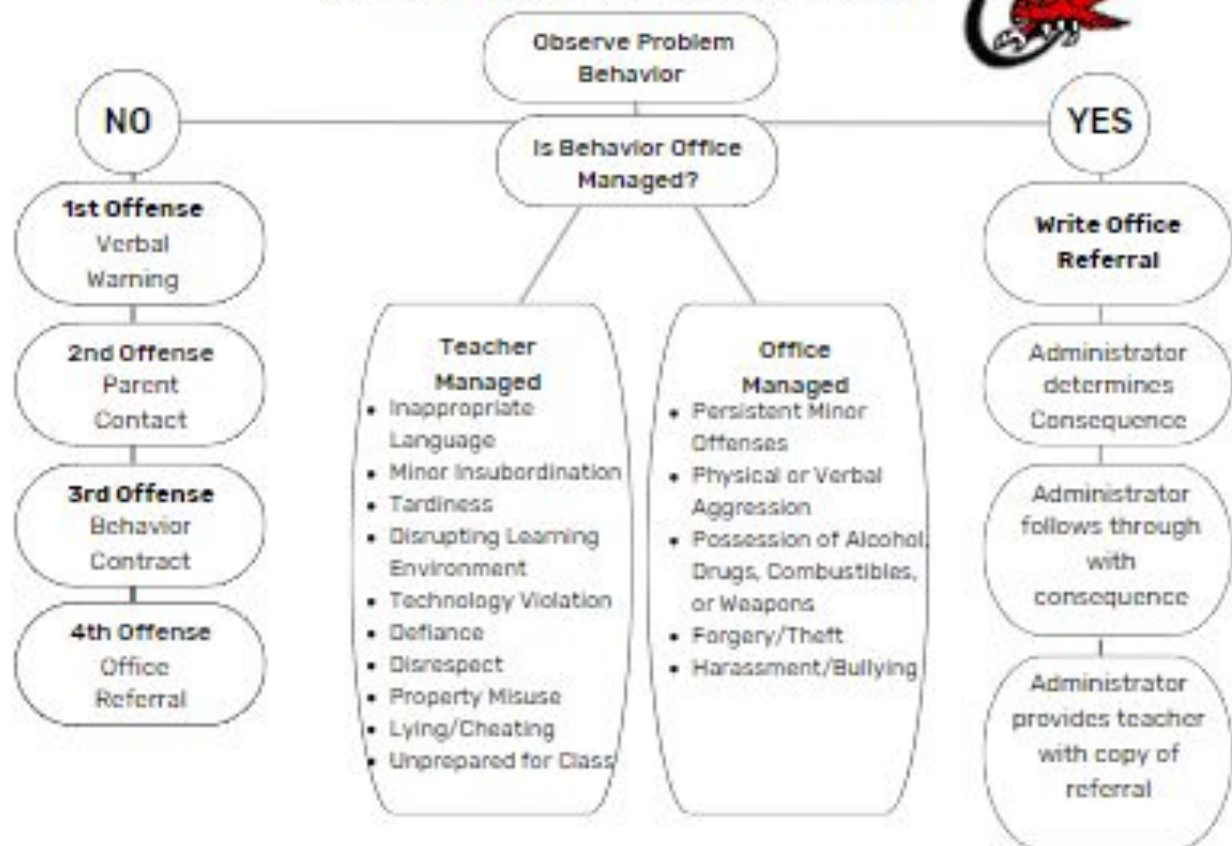

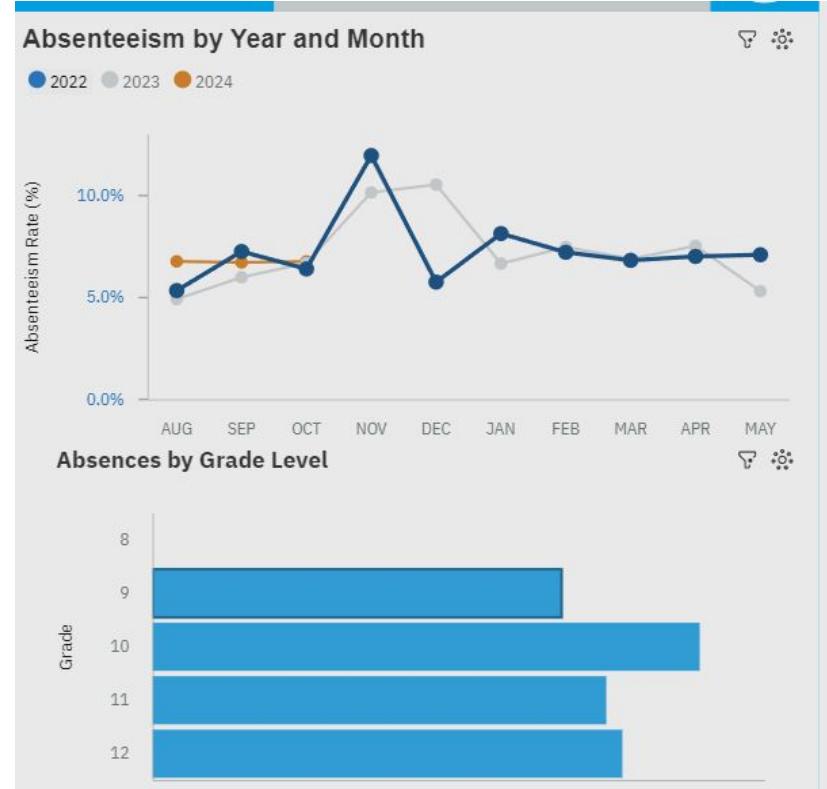
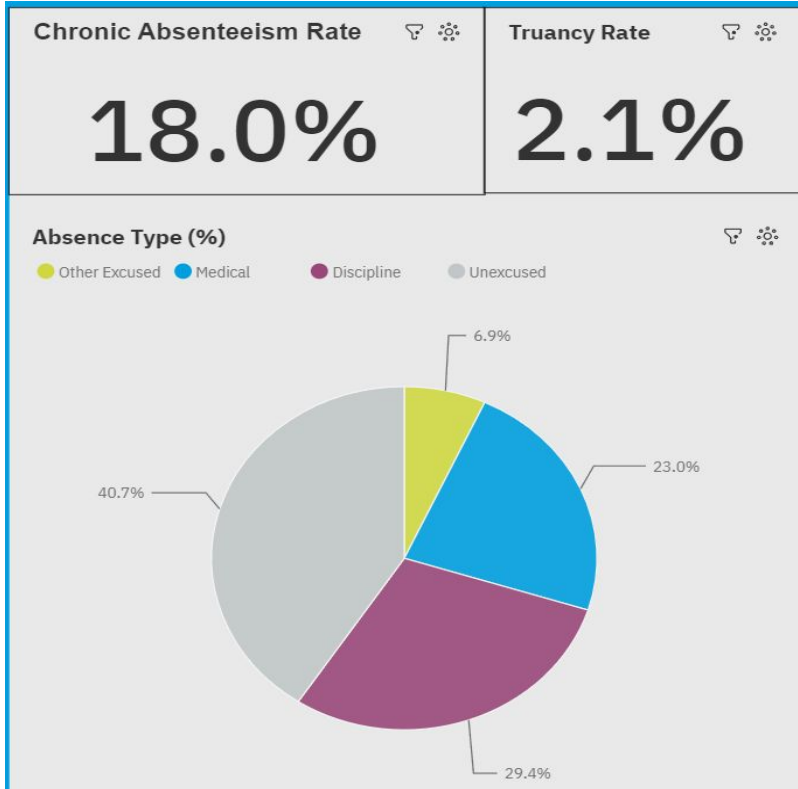
# DISCIPLINE FLOWCHART

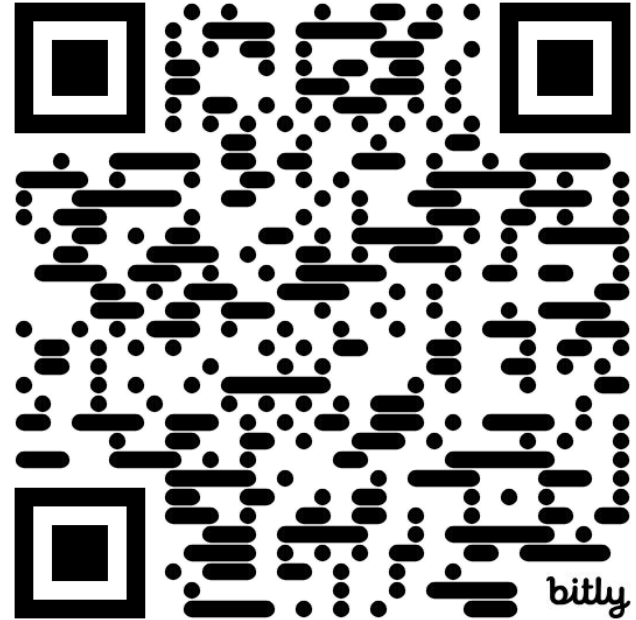
